

I.S.U. CASS COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Scholarship for study at IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

SCHOLARSHIP: A \$ 500 scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating High School senior from Cass County, Iowa. The scholarship will be divided equally at registration for each of two freshman semesters.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be either a resident of Cass County or graduating from one of the High Schools in Cass County. Applicants must be in the upper one-third of their class. Applicants must have been accepted for enrollment at Iowa State.

PROCEDURES:

1. Complete the attached application form.
2. Attach all documents requested in the application form.
3. Mail the completed application and documents to:

4. Application must be postmarked on or before April 15th.

SELECTION:

Scholarship: grade point, ACT score, along with curriculum selections will all be considered.

Leadership: in school, church, and community activities. Participation in activities will receive some credit. Leadership roles will count much more

Need: will be considered, but will be used mostly as a tie-breaker.

Interview: Finalists may be interviewed by a selection committee.

Essay: Describe why you chose Iowa State, and your career objectives.

AWARDING: Scholarship will be awarded at high school class night. Also, recipients will be invited and be recognized at a Cass County I.S.U. meeting.

ENROLLMENT: Recipient will receive a letter of certification from the scholarship committee. Scholarship credit will be granted to recipient at the time of registration by presenting this letter.
